1. a) Explain the circumstances in which culpable homicide amounts to murder. If there any exception? If so, illustrate with the leading case Reg. Vs. Govindo. [8]
- b) M knowingly strikes Z who is laboring under such a disease that a blow is likely to caused his death. Z dies consequence of the blow, although the blow might not have been sufficient in the ordinary course of nature to cause the death. Does commit any offence? What shall be the maximum punishment for such offence? [2]
2. a) Define theft. Discuss when theft is extortion and robbery is dacoity with reference to the relevant provisions of the Penal Code, 1860. [8]
- b) A meets Z on a highway, A shows a pistol and demands Z's purse. In consequence, Z surrenders his purse. Does a commit any offence? Explain. [2]
3. a) Analyze with illustration the ingredients of 'cheating' and 'criminal breach of trust' with reference to the relevant provisions of the Penal Code. [7]
- b) X says, "As far as I know, Z is an honest man who never stole anything from poor". Is the statement defamatory? Why? [2]
- c) Prescribe the punishment for criminal intimidation. [1]
4. a) When does the hurt designated as "grievous hurt"? [5]
- b) Is the miscarriage homicidal? Is the miscarriage offence when both couple agreed? [5]
5. a) Describe the terms wrongful restraint and wrongful confinement with punishments. What is the maximum punishment for wrongfully confining a person for more than 10 days? [8]
- b) 'A' intending or knowing himself to be likely permanently to disfigure 'B's gives 'B' a blow which does not permanently disfigure 'B's face, but which causes B to suffer severe bodily pain for the space of twenty days. State the punishment for such offence [2]
6. What is the procedure of taking cognizance and trial by Special Tribunal, constituted under the Special Powers Act, 1974? What are the offences triable by the Special Tribunal? [10]
7. a) Define 'arms' and 'ammunition' under the Arms Act 1878. When, why and by whom a license be cancelled or suspended? [7]
- b) More than 25 grams of Heroin(Narcotics) was recovered from the possession of a person whom kept it in violation of section 9(1) of the Madok Drabbya Niontron Ain, 2018. Describe the quantum of punishment prescribed by law. [3]
