(b) What is riot? A joined in unlawful assembly with deadly weapon but B joined without any weapon. A started to use his weapon but B did nothing. Illustrate liability of A and B.
2. (a) Enumerate 'affray' with an example. [3+4+3]
(b) Distinguish between wrongful restraint and wrongful confinement.
(c) Write the punishments for causing disappearance of evidence of offence to screen the offender.
3. (a) What do you mean by sedition'? [3+7]
(b) Z, a driver of a public transport and was coming from Dhaka to Chittagong with full of passengers. The road was free and he was driving with a high speed as there was no sign at road side to limit its speed. At a sudden, an adult man with normal sense attempted to cross the high way and pulled over by the bus resulting spot dead. Is not the driver liable? Answer with case references and considering the doctrine of 'last opportunity'.
4. (a) A, with an intent to kill a deer, fires to it but kills Mr. B who was going through behind the jungle. Is A liable for murder or culpable homicide? [5+5]
(b) What are the concrete circumstances under which culpable homicide considered as 'murder'?
5. (a) Is there any safety measures and safeguard in the Penal Code for safe birth of 'unborn child'?
(b) What is meant by 'hurt'? Prescribe the punishment for negligent act endangering human life and safety. [4+6]
