2. Define the term 'shufaa' according to Muslim law. Who are entitled to exercise the right of pre-emption? When does this right arise and when is it lost? What is 'Talaq- i- Mowasibat'? 10
3. Explain the term Hizanot in Muslim Law. How many kinds of guardianships in Muslim Law? What are the considerations to make an order by the court for the appointment of a guardian? 10

Summarize the law relating to the guardianship of minor's property and person under the Muslim law explaining in this context the powers of a (i) legal and (ii) de factor guardian for disposition of minor's property 10

5. Explain the term Hiba and wasiyat in Muslim law. When can a hiba be revoked and when cannot? Differentiate hiba- bil-Iwad and Hiba-bi-shartil-iwad. 10
