2. Illustrate the power, functions and removal process of the President of the people's republic of Bangladesh.
3. *"Tenure of the Ministers depends on the pleasure of the Prime Minister"*–Explain it mentioning the appointment and status of the Prime Minister and other ministers.
4. Summarize the qualifications and disqualifications of a member of parliament. How does the seat of a MP become vacant?
5. Define the term 'writ'. Who can exercise writ jurisdiction? What are the different kinds of writ? Discuss with examples.
6. Clarify the issues of the 16th Amendment of the Constitution of Bangladesh in details. How is it contradictory with the principle of independence of judiciary?
7. Write short note on following topics:
 - a. Equality before law ;
 - b. Freedom of Speech;
 - c. Cabinet; and
 - d. Impeachment of the President.
