Answer any **Five** of the following questions.

1. Explain the inherent power of the High Court Division under section 561(A) of Code of Criminal Procedure. What are the principles to be followed by the court in exercising such power?
2. What is meant by transfer of criminal cases? Under what circumstances can Session Judge's court exercise the transfer power? Discuss the powers of the high court division regarding transfer of criminal case.
3. What are the procedures to be followed to frame a formal charge by the courts of magistrate and courts of session? What are the contents of a charge? Discuss the procedures to amend a charge.
4. What are the grounds to be ensured to file a criminal revision? Point out the rules and procedures to file a criminal revision. Make a clear distinction between criminal appeal and criminal revision.
5. What is meant by bail on security and bail with surety? Under what circumstances may the court grant bail in a non-bailable offence? Make a clear distinction between bailable and non-bailable offences.
6. Discuss the general rules and procedures to file a criminal appeal? When does appeal not lie? Discuss powers and functions of an appellate court.
7. Explain the stages of trial before court of Magistrates. What are the differences between the trial of session judges and magistrate court?
