3. Evaluate the contribution of Nawab Abdul Latif to the socio-cultural and educational development in the Muslim society of Bengal.
4. What was the historical necessity for the formation of Muslim League in 1906 as a Muslim nationalist political party in Bengal? Evaluate its role in achieving the independence from British colonial rule.
5. Estimate the nature and trend of Language Movement of 1952. How did it lead to the independence movement of Bangladesh in 1971?
6. Explain the basic characteristics of the constitution of Bangladesh and write the important features of its 15th amendment.
7. Write short notes on **any two** of the following topics:
 - a) Six-point demands of 1966
 - b) 11 sectors of Liberation War of 1971
 - c) Administrative structure of Bangladesh
 - d) Principles of Bangladesh Foreign Policy.
