## ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY CHITTAGONG

Islamic University Chittagong (IUC) is a private university established in 1995 under 'The Private University Act 1992' in the second largest city of Bangladesh, Port-City Chittagong. 'Islamisation of Knowledge' is the motto of this university.

There are 11 public universities in Bangladesh, which are run and funded by the Government, aiming at creating scope for Bangladeshi students for higher education. Unfortunately these universities are not adequate to cope with the present day academic need of the country. Their capacity in taking the students is very limited. As a result, thousands of students are rushing to the neighbouring country India for higher education and even for higher secondary education.

### ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY - WHY?

The Islamic University Chittagong (IUC) is one of the Govt. approved Degree awarding Private Universities in Bangladesh. The credit for the idea of establishing this ideal University goes to ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY CHITTAGONG TRUST (IUCT) which is the founder organization and sponsoring authority of the University. This trust is a non-political, non-profit and non-governmental voluntary organization but a social welfare and educational Trust. It is registered with the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh under the Societies Act XXI of 1860. This Trust foresaw the strong need for a University under Private initiative in view of absence of higher learning and dissemination of knowledge based on Islamic viewpoints as derived from Qur'an and Sunnah at the Government education sector of the country. Worked on the idea beginning as early as in 1990, the Trust discussed the concept of or Private Islamic University with group of intellectuals, Islamic thinkers, researchers and educationists, home and abroad. It was these Islamic personalities who came forward to materialize the idea of such an unique and exceptional institution by putting in their thinking, energies and financial supports. Consequently, in 1992, they established an anchor organization called Islamic University Chittagong Trust whose two year's long efforts were rewarded by the Grace of Allah (SWT) when it founded the Islamic University Chittagong in 1994, thus, the long-cherished dream of the inhabitants of the Port-City Chittagong, Bangladesh meshed with of noble and sincere attempts of those founders was materialized and came into reality.

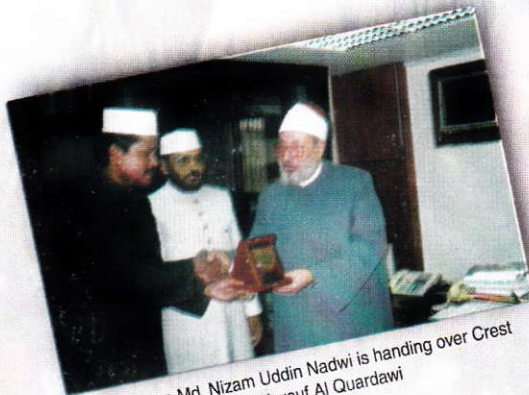

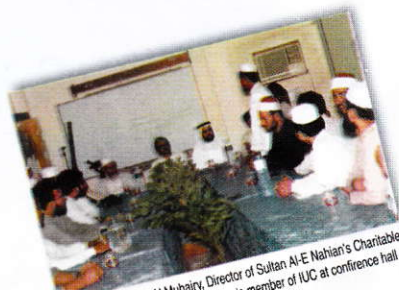

## Islamic University Chittagong Fundamental Characteristics

1. It is a non-profit and non-commercial Institution administered by a registered Trust. The Trust is composed of members drawn from various different academic and non-academic background.
2. The University is a centre for equal opportunity in education irrespective of religion, gender, race and nationality, students are free to enrol in any suitable course.
3. The University allows no student politics and organisations. It is free from session jam and it fosters conducive and moral academic atmosphere.
4. Female students of the university follow a particular dress-code prescribed by the Islamic shari'ah.
5. Students are given basic knowledge of Islam together with modern scientific education to make them fit for the next millennium.
6. Special attention is given to the development of Islamic character in students. Students are required to follow certain rules and regulations in the University and Hostels relating thereto.
7. Special emphasis is given on English and Arabic language proficiency. All students must complete the prescribed language courses.
8. Computer literacy is compulsory for all students. Computer laboratories have been provided in all Departments to facilitate the programme for the students.

9. Arabic language has been made compulsory for all students regardless of discipline and department with the objective that they may compete in and meet the demands of the work at home and abroad.
10. This University follows the internationally recognized credit hour system. Thus, it ensures quality education acceptable to foreign Universities.
11. The University has signed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with several foreign Universities, which give the students greater opportunities for higher education and credit transfer in these Universities.
12. The University makes modern science and technology an inseparable part of the education system. Internet & E-mail, using OHP have been ensured. A separate student service center has been established.
13. The University employs foreign teachers and gives preference to choice who are educated at the foreign Universities, and welcomes enrollment of international students.
14. English is the medium of instruction in the Faculties of Modern Sciences and Business Administration, as well as Arabic is medium of instruction for the Faculty of Shariah & Islamic Studies.

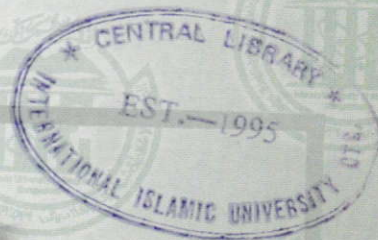
