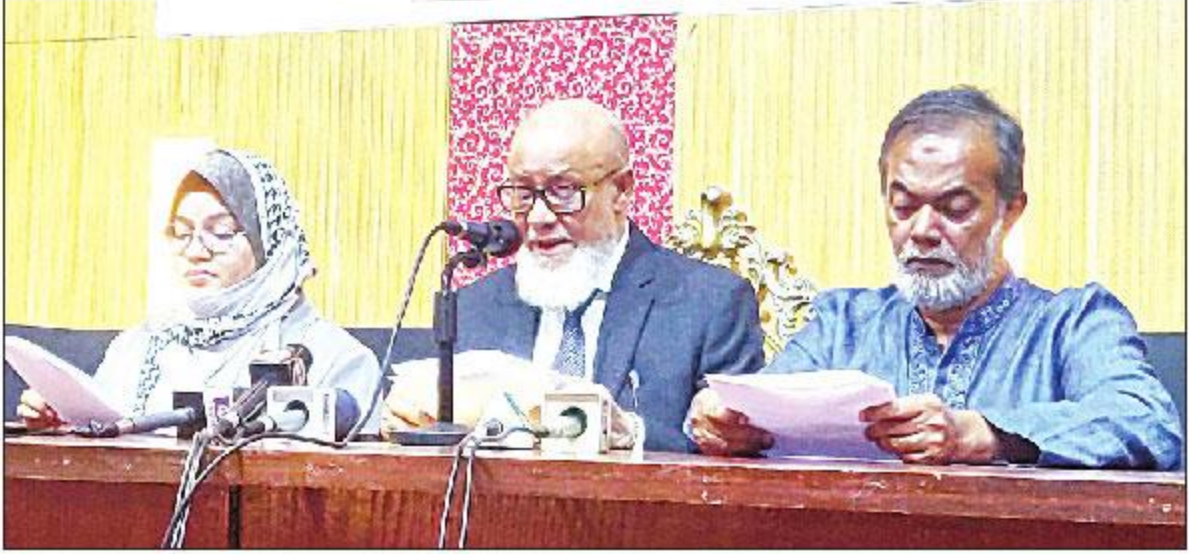

International Islamic University Chittagong (IIUC) is one of the leading government-approved private universities in Bangladesh founded in 1995. The Board of Trustees of International Islamic University Chittagong has been reformed through the directives of the Ministry of Education, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh and started its journey formally on 8 March 2021. Now, the BoT is enriched with renowned educationists, scholars, freedom fighters, political and social leaders. It is committed to restore the original objective of the university; to serve the Nation and the Ummah. The motto of the university is to "Combine Quality with Morality." Fourteen Bachelors and Eleven Masters programs are now functioning at IIUC under Six Faculties.

Salient Features of IIUC:

The Center for Research & Publication (CRP) of IIUC aims to create a conducive environment for the researches. CRP publishes three peer reviewed Journals annually. IIUC has successfully organized 14 International Conferences on different important issues relating to Science, ICT, education, ethics, Islamization of knowledge, etc. A specialized research centre titled Bangabandhu Research Centre for Islam and Interreligious Dialogue (BRCIID) has been inaugurated in IIUC on 1st April 2021 in order to contribute to the original humanitarian welfare intention of world religions particularly of Islam through a deeper and mutual understanding of the great religions of the world.
