#### 1. Introduction:

At IIUC, we define success not merely by career accomplishments, but also by moral character and values enshrined in Islamic principles. Today in the 21st century, it is not enough just to have technical skills. The social, moral and behavioral aspect of leading life as a good human being and striving to be a productive member of society is equally important. It should inspire a community spirit for the greater good that the Almighty wants us to dedicate our lives to. Therefore, the objective of IIUC is to create a new generation of educated and motivated Muslim youths and followers of any other religion who want to be equipped with academic excellence and moral height. We aim to provide our students life-long foundation in values, ethics, and cultural understanding. IIUC has a distinct mission and vision which drives its objectives, education policy, evaluation system and even its outstanding sponsoring body of International reputation.

*Now a brief description on IIUC's Mission, Vision, efforts and expectations are given below:*

## **2. Mission, Vision & Objectives of the University:**

**2.1** The Mission of the University is to revive the glorious past of the Muslim Ummah, as they were the patrons of scholarship and imparters of education for the whole mankind, through establishing Universities, Educational Institutions, Research Centers and Public Libraries during the Golden Periods of Middle ages.

**2.2** The Vision of the University is to establish this University as the Centre of Excellence in the South Asian Region, in different areas of scholarship like Shariah Sciences, Business Studies, Modern Sciences and Engineering and Law etc. Keeping its door open to the admission seekers of Asian and East Asian region, regardless of the consideration of race and religion.

## **2.3. The Objectives of the University:**

**a.** To create a new generation of Muslim youths who will be equipped with academic excellence, professional expertise and adorned with moral height.

**b.** To follow a policy of continued Islamization of Knowledge and academic curricula in different branches of knowledge so that its students can imbibe the true spirit of Islam as an effective guiding principle in their profession and daily life.

## **2.4. The Motto of the University:**

The Motto of the International Islamic University Chittagong is "*IIUC Combines Quality with Morality*".

## **3. The Characteristics of IIUC and its Action Plan:**

The characteristics of IIUC and its action plan for attaining the above mentioned mission, vision and objectives can be summarized as follows:

### **3.1. Introducing an Integrated Education Policy:**

An Integrated Education Policy refers to an education where a student achieves holistic learning through awareness of his surrounding and other relevant knowledge bases. For example, a student of the Faculty of Science at a public university does not need to study any course on Religion, Social Science or History. On the other hand, a student of Literature does not need to study anything about Religion, Social Science or other practical sciences. But in an Integrated education policy, a student must study Religion, History, Computer, some course of interdisciplinary subjects, some

languages like English / Arabic / French / German etc. so that a student may be prepared as all rounded personality with multidimensional exposure and broad outlook.

### **3.2. Regular Orientation Process:**

In an integrated Education policy, the students are not only offered some courses that need to be taken for graduation requirement; but rather the student has to undergo regular training and an orientation process to identify his latent talent and to develop them through proper nursing, especially with a target to prepare himself for a future leadership role.

IIUC has a separate Division for this purpose called Student Affairs Division (STAD). Our students are advised to keep themselves in close contact with this Division.

### **3.3. Continuous Evaluation Process:**

*One of the essential characteristics of an Integrated Education System is the Continuous Evaluation Process:*

In this process a student is evaluated in a multidimensional manner, such as, (a) his regularity in attending the classes (b) his ability to perform assignments and class tests in time. (c) his scores in the Mid-Term Exams & the Finals.

Under this system, a student must be very regular, work hard every day to ensure a high grade in a course. The continuous evaluation process automatically filters lazy students with no real desire to seek knowledge.

### **3.4. An International Atmosphere:**

Unlike most of the Universities of Bangladesh, IIUC is an International University which essentially requires that the door of admission in this University is not limited to the native students of the country only but also open for the admission seekers of foreign countries, rather IIUC accepts some students from abroad with scholarship. Presently more than 150 students (both male & female) from China, Nepal, India, Sri Lanka and Maldives are studying in IIUC in different programs.

### **3.5. Financial Assistance to general Students:**

IIUC offers generous financial support to its students under different categories. e.g.

- i. Waiver on the basis of SSC & HSC results. (for undergraduate student)
- ii. Waiver on the basis of Semester result.

- iii. Waiver two or more siblings study at IIUC simultaneously.
- iv. Corporate waiver in EMBA for certain number of officers enrolled from a single organization under corporate arrangement.
- v. Apart from the above categories, a good number of IIUC students also enjoy scholarships at different rates sponsored by Islamic Personalities or Organizations abroad.

### **3.6. Facility for Study abroad with Credit Transfer:**

Presently, about 50 students have transferred credit to study at different prestigious Institutions & Universities abroad. Some of them have even secured full scholarship, showing the high quality of education that peer institutions place on IIUC. Some of these peer institutions are the Al-Azhar University in Cairo, various universities in USA, Canada, Germany and Sweden, and the International Islamic University of Malaysia (IIUM).

### **4. Membership of prestigious organizations and signing up MoU with renowned institutions:**

IIUC has succeeded in securing membership of prestigious organizations such as the Federation of the Universities of Islamic World (FUIW) under ISESCO and the Association of the Commonwealth Universities.

IIUC has also recently entered into a Memorandum of Understanding several Institutions of higher learning in Asia, South Asia, Africa, North America and the UK.

### **5. Separate Campus for Female Students:**

One unique feature of IIUC is the availability of a separate campus for the female student body. Currently, more than three thousand female students are studying at this campus.

In this connection, IIUC has taken a bold and courageous step in constructing a skyscraper in the heart of the Chittagong city. The skyscraper will be 20 storied high with an estimated budget of 10 million dollars.



### **6. IIUC in the eye of the Muslim World & Islamic Scholars:**

IIUC is regarded highly by various Muslim Organizations and Institutes. This is due to the fact that the expectation of the leaders of Ummah from IIUC is very high. Many would like to see IIUC as

a Center of Excellence in the contemporary Muslim world, and as such, they always try to contribute to the development of this University with all their abilities and sincerity. This is one of the fundamental reasons why IIUC has so far been able to implement different projects estimated at least 1.5 billion taka in local currency. May Allah (s.w.t.) give us the best of Tawfique.

### **7. Our Responsibilities:**

In the context of the present situation, our responsibilities are many to IIUC, to our students, to the society and to the Ummah at large.

#### **7.1 To the IIUC & its students:**

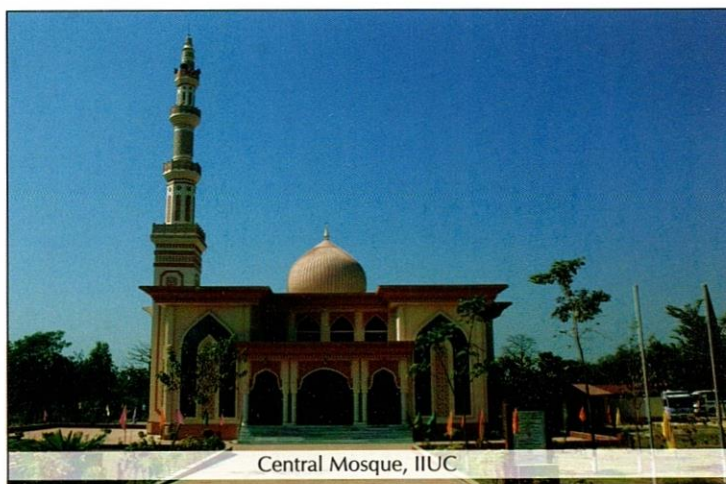
### **Welcome to IIUC Business School**

**My Dear Freshers,**

*Assalamu Alaikum Wa Rahmatullahi Wa Barakatuhu.*

A very pleasant good morning to you all.

Student Affairs Division or STAD is one of the administrative divisions in IIUC. We don't find any such division in our Public or Private Universities. Following the footsteps of International Islamic University Malaysia, IIUC decided to introduce this division with great enthusiasm to develop our students physically, culturally and mentally.

**Roles and functions of STAD:**

To organize and conduct student-related programs.

To provide training and instructions to our students.

To explore the potentials of the students.

To recommend, approve, coordinate, advise and monitor programs.

STAD aims at attaining and developing outlooks and characteristics like faith in Allah, correct Islamic knowledge, proper practice, Ukuwah, mutual love and respect, encouragement of students' active participation in co-curricular activities to create in them critical, rational and strategic mind, skill development, discipline and leadership. It also works for promotion of the philosophy and objectives of IIUC.

**STAD Units:**

IIUC has many programs under different units of STAD such as,

**1. Leadership Training Unit**, which covers Dynamic Leadership Training Camps (DLTC), Leadership Training Program (LTP), etc.

**2. Student Activities Unit**, which covers mainly seminars, symposia, discussion meetings in observance of important national and Islamic days and occasions, Orientation Program, convocation, formation of nuqaba council, formation of clubs and societies like debating club, games and sports club, literary and cultural societies.

**3. Sports and Recreation Unit**, which covers annual sports, intrauniversity competition, indoor and outdoor games, tour to historical places and business organizations, pleasure trip/picnic and study tour at home and abroad.

**4. Public Speaking and Cultural Unit**, which covers debate competition, essay competition, cultural festival, award giving ceremony, computer club and IIUC literary society, public lecture series, etc.



**5. Hostel Unit**, which coordinates the hostel activities, allocate seats for the students and works as member secretary of Hostel Management Committee.

**6. Student Service Unit**, which covers services like photocopying, teleCell, e-mail, fax, laminating, etc.

**7. Counseling and Career Guidance Unit**, which covers group and individual counseling, career and job placement, preserving CVs of the graduates, advising students to solve their problems. IIUC organized a successful Job Fair in 2003.

**8. Special Unit**, which covers general administration, notices/letters regarding different programs and issues, publishing brochures, leaflet regarding student activities, Study Class and others, publication of IIUC magazine.

**9. Disciplinary Unit**, which covers introduction of Students' General Discipline Rules, holding Discipline Committee meetings, issuance and preserving all show-cause notices and replies thereto, circulation of decisions of the Disciplinary Committee to departments / students / divisions concerned.

*Following are some of the rules and regulations not mentioned in the papers:*

1. Every student should have comprehensive knowledge about the University, Semester System, Grading Systems, Examination rules and all other academic matters, regarding different divisions such as ACAD, STAD, ACFD, PHRD, SDSWD, PPD, FAD and LID. And one can learn this from the booklets & pamphlets already available in the office.

2. IIUC has not introduced any uniform for the convenience of the students but introduced a unique dress code. Students must come to the University in a befitting dress as described in the attire and dress code. Students must come with matriculation card or ID. Security personnel have right to refrain one from entering the campus without ID and proper dress.

3. Usually the office time of IIUC is 9.00 A.M to 5.00 P. M. Library and laboratories are kept open till 8.00 P.M. everyday. Students are advised to come to the Campus keeping 30 minutes time in hand before the scheduled class. While you enter the University go to the notice boards, see whether there is any notice for you. It may help you a lot.

4. Offer salam with smiling face to teachers, friends and everybody you meet in the Campus. Salam makes people friends and eliminates bitterness.
5. Attend the classes timely. Put your signature in the attendance sheet.
6. Try to conversate, exchange views in the classroom or in the office room either in English or in Arabic. Try to develop an international environment.

Accordingly, Staff Development and Student Welfare Division (SDSWD) has been launched to materialize this endeavor.

### Main Objectives of SDSWD:

- o Helping the teachers in their academic development and the Administrative Staff in their professional skill development.
- o Organizing training programs, study circle, seminar and symposium for developing intellectual base and morality of the academic staff and officers.
- o Providing financial assistance and scholarship for the brilliant and poor students.
- o Arranging training programs to develop the morality of the students.

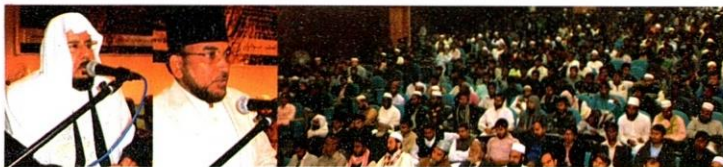
The Division basically works for the development of both the teachers and the students of IIUC.

As today's Orientation Program is to introduce the freshers with the functions of different Divisions, only the functions and programs of Student Welfare unit are stated here:

#### a) Scholarship:

SDSWD provides scholarship to the students of various categories ranging from Tk. 6000 to Tk. 15,000 each semester. The eligibility of getting the scholarship is measured by the morality and practice of Islam in real life of the student.

Besides, the minimum GPA of winning the scholarship is 3.80. If the scholarship awarded students fail to maintain desired GPA, the scholarship would be withdrawn. The scholarship is primarily given for



one year. The list of the scholarship receivers will be renewed / altered according to the result every year.

#### **Foreign Scholarship :**

This Division is continuing its effort to create opportunity of higher education in reputed



foreign universities for the meritorious and ideal students of IIUC. IIUC sends 2 best students of the postgraduate level Scholarship for Higher Education:

This Division is continuing its effort to create opportunity of higher education in reputed foreign universities for the meritorious and ideal students of IIUC. IIUC sends 2 best students of the postgraduate level abroad for pursuing higher studies each year. It should be noted that IIUC aims at appointing some of them as faculty members considering their academic excellence as well as commitment to Islam. Mr. Ashraful Islam, a brilliant student of the Department of Computer Science & Engineering, joined IIUC after completing MSc. from England. He enjoyed full scholarship from IIUC.

Another 2 bright IIUC graduates of CCE (Late Md. Abdullah Al Masud) & DBA (Md. Zahedul Alam) have completed higher studies at Asian Institute of Technology (AIT, Thailand) with full Scholarship of SDSWD.

Besides, Graduating students interested to transfer credit to foreign university will be helped accordingly by the Division.

#### **B) Financial Assistance:**

IIUC offers generous financial assistance to the poor and meritorious students. Apart from the amount granted for regular scholarship as mentioned above, IIUC keeps 5% of its revenue for granting financial assistance to the students based on semester results. Priority is given to those who are from poor family but meritorious.

- \* As per IIUC's existing rule a student may get the chance of full free studentship if he/she obtains Golden GPA in HSC and SSC exam or equivalent.
- \* 25% waiver on Tuition fee if two or more siblings study at IIUC simultaneously.
- \* Only the registered students may get financial assistance.
- \* Students studying foundation course (FEC) or of 1st semester are not considered for financial assistance. But siblings and Golden GPA holders may get T.F. waiver in spite of being students of 1st semester.

The whole process of Financial Assistance & Tuition fee waiver is supervised by Staff Development & Student Welfare Division (SDSWD). Students are suggested to contact SDSWD office for any query regrading Financial Assistance.

### C) Foreign Students Unit:

This unit of SDSWD looks after the affairs of Foreign students. It makes regular correspondence with foreign organizations/institutions to collect foreign students, and arrange to sign MoU with prospective organizations/Universities abroad. Mentionable that about 170 foreign students from India, Srilanka, Nepal , Maldives, China, Somalia, Ethiopia have been studying in IIUC.

I would like to congratulate the freshers for getting chance for admission at IIUC in the Summer Semester-2014 and cordially welcome you to IIUC.

### Introducing the Academic Affairs Division (ACAD)

You know well the ACAD where you completed your formalities for admission. I would like to highlight major functions of ACAD for your information as follows:

\* Admission \* Registration \* Examination \* Information & Advising

- **Admission:** All admission activities are performed by ACAD. Planning for Advertisement, Selling & Receiving of Admission Form, Arrangement for Admission Test, Publication of Result, Issuing Offer Letter for Admission and Completion of Admission at IIUC.

- **Registration:** After admission and at the time of semester commencement, every student needs to be registered with courses. Registration Form distribution, collection, correction, sorting, inserting in the software and finally processing, every task is supervised and maintained at ACAD.

• **Examination:** ACAD supervises and coordinates all final examinations, processes marks and publishes results. It issues admit cards to the candidates of Final Examination and certificates also. ACAD is also the office of Exams

• **Information & Advising:** ACAD provides information to admission seekers, visitors and advises the existing students regarding admission, registration, examination and publications or any other problem arises during study at IIUC.

## **Academic & Credit Hour System at IIUC**

### **i. Academic Calendar:**

IIUC follows the semester system and to implement the semester system, Academic Calendar is prepared for each semester. There are two regular semesters in an academic year the course in question, drop of the current semester, expulsion for an academic year or expulsion from the University, based on the weight and gravity of the offence.

### **# Policy for Improvement of Grade**

- It should be exercised within the two consecutive Semesters.
- That payment shall be made in full on credit hour basis.
- That the last grade will be computed in the transcript and the previous grade will be nullified and marked with 'R' grade (as retake of the course), which has no effect on GPA or CGPA.

### **# Publication of Result by Transcripts:**

Results of Each Semester are distributed to every student normally at the beginning of the following semester. Official Transcripts are issued during graduation and upon written request of a student who has paid all fees. Partial transcripts may also be issued in the same manner to existing students. However, a fee of TK. 50/- is charged for partial transcript/ testimonial of a semester and TK. 250/- is charged for each set of Final Transcript and original certificate respectively.

### **# Student Identification Card:**

All students are issued Digital Student Identification Card known as ID Card upon admission to the University. This card allows the students to get access to the University facilities.

Finally I would request you to follow and remember the points given below:

- Go through the Admission Handbook;
- Follow the Academic Calendar;
- Complete your Course Registration in each semester within the deadline;
- Repeat the course/s within two consecutive semesters;
- Apply by prescribed form for Dropping semester within the

registration period for temporary discontinuation of study;

- Collect each semester's result and evaluate yourself;
- Check the Notice Board of ACAD daily;
- Carry the Identity Card during stay at Campus;
- For any query, feel free to contact the ACAD or Departments office.

I expect the successful completion of your study at IIUC and wish you to achieve your target in your life.

Since IIUC is following the Open Credit Hour System, the student may register the expected number of credits with the recommendation of his/her respective academic advisor and the approval of the Head of the Department or the Dean of the Faculty or the Pro-Vice-Chancellor as the case may be.

### **# Criteria for Repeat Courses**

Under the following circumstances, the course repeat can be held.

- For 'D' or 'F' grade holder the course must be repeated within the next 2 consecutive semesters. Prerequisite courses should be repeated on priority basis.
- The improved grade will be computed in the final transcript and the previous grade/s (i.e. D or F) will be marked with 'R' grade (as retake the course) which has no effect on GPA or CGPA.
- If any student earns 'C' or above grade for any course he / she would not be allowed to repeat.

### **# Class Attendance Requirement**

Students are required to attend all lectures, tutorials, seminars, lab works etc. of courses that they have registered for. Normally 80% attendance is required to allow a student to take the semester final examination. If any student has class attendance below 60% he/she will be barred from attending final examination.

### **# Campus/Department Transfer**

An application addressing to the Pro Vice-Chancellor through the Head of the Department has to be submitted to ACAD. After getting approval, the incumbent has to pay Tk. 5000/- for the students of Shari'ah, Arts & Humanities and Law faculty and Tk. 10,000/- for the students of all other faculties.

### **# Cheating in Examination:**

When a student is found to have committed a breach of any provision of the Examinations Rules and Regulations or any procedure made there under or any instruction made by an authority under these Regulations, such candidate shall be deemed to have committed an offence and will be liable for disciplinary punishment. Such punishment can be cancellation.

- Students are required to collect book's deposit slip from ACFD and then all fees are to be paid through this deposit slip in the IBBL, Chawkbazar branch, CTG.
- It should be noted that the Course Registration Form would not be accepted by ACFD if any student fails to produce book Deposit slip in ACFD in time.
- If any student is allowed to repeat the Semester then he/she is required to pay 50% of the tuition fees along with the Semester fee and If any student is allowed to repeat any course/ courses then he/she is required to pay 50% of the tuition fees (on credit hour basis). However, in a nutshell this is the procedure regarding payment of. fees & charges. Further if you need any other financial information please feel free to get in touch with us within the office hour and we assure you that we will be beside you all-time.

**Library General Rules:**

*Library Opening Hours (Permanent Campus):*

Saturday to Wednesday	8.00 am to 8.00 pm
Thursday	8.00 am to 1.00 pm
Friday	3.00 pm to 8.00 pm

*Opening Hours of Seminar Library of MBA (Male & Female Campus):*

Saturday to Wednesday	2.00 pm to 9.00 pm
Thursday	9.00 am to 9.00 pm
Friday	9.00 am to 9.00 pm

*\* During the prayer-time, library comes to a stop.*

**Library Membership:** If you intend to be a member of the library you have to deposit Tk. 1,000/- (One thousand only) to Accounts & Finance Division (ACFD) as Library Caution Money (refundable). Then you have to fill up the Library Membership Application Form and submit it along with two stamp-size color photographs and show your ID card or registration form and ACFD receipt (Library caution money) to the circulation desk to have a library card.

**Issue System:** you have to Produce / submit your library card to the circulation desk when borrowing library materials. Library card will not be transferable. We are giving you four books at a time for fifteen days.

**Catalogue:** You can choose books from the catalogue book or computer database and can be borrowed by submitting a filled up requisition slip. Library staffs always pay much attention for every user. Please feel free to ask us for any kind of help in searching of the suitable reading materials.



Penalty: Library materials borrowed must be returned or renewed by the due time. Otherwise you will have to pay fine of Tk. 1.00 per day for each book.

Reference & Photocopy: The users need reference books, journal, question etc. for photocopying. It may be done by a staff of the library by advanced payment or by one's own self. This option may be provided usually during Evening Shift. Photocopied materials taken by own self must be returned by the due time. Otherwise you will have to pay fine of Tk. 1.00 per hour for each book.

Carefulness & Behavior: A library is reading and research zone for the readers and researchers. Therefore, silence should be strictly observed in the Library premises. Smoking, eating, and drinking are strictly prohibited inside the library. Bags, Umbrellas, parcels, etc. are not to be brought into the library and may be kept in Library Bag Room.

Collection: Our book collection consists of text and reference books on all subjects offered at IIUC. A large numbers of Journals, Periodicals & Magazines from home and abroad are available in the Library. 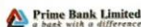
