IIUC and Programming Contest

The year 1997 was a land mark in the history of programming contest in Bangladesh. That year Dr. Abul L. Haque, former Head of the department of Computer Science of North South University, took the initiative to make Dhaka a contest site for Asia region of ACM ICPC, the most prestigious programming contest in the world. His timely step opened the door for our students to compete with the world's most meritorious computer science students. North South University hosted that big event to become the part of the history. The history began with the success of Suman Kumar Nath, Rezaul Alam Chowdhury (Saikat) and Tarique Mesbaul Islam (Susham). The three S raised the flag of Bangladesh for the first time in the World Finals of ACM ICPC in the banner of Bengal Tigers. Dr. M. Kaykobad was the coach of the team. Prof. Kaykobad is now an institution in promoting programming contests activities in Bangladesh. A new generation has now been emerged and the students of IIUC have joined with these enthusiastic boys and girls of new age. Long days have been passed since then and IIUC is now playing a major role in staging, participating and advocating Programming Contests in Bangladesh.

At that very outset, in 1997, IIUC did not participate in ACM ICPC. From 1998 it has started participating in ACM ICPC and since then it has been more and more involving in these activities, its participation is increasing and new feathers are being tied to its crown day by day. Let us have a quick look on how IIUC performed in the ACM ICPC.

Programming Contests have brought a big opportunity for the students. In our regular classes we do not go for highest level of perfection in solving problems. Due to limitation of time and our effort in formulating problems and testing solutions with extreme data it is a daunting task for us to check the correctness of solutions with perfection. Interest in participating programming contests organized by ACM and also in online contests organized by University of Valladolid of Spain and contest organized by our universities is helping the students to achieve such perfection that the correctness of their solution could be judged by a machine. Such perfection is very important in developing large systems requiring participation of a large number of programmers, where output of a programmer's program becomes input to another's program. Here no inaccuracy even in the presentation format is acceptable.

The success history of IIUC began in the 1st National Computer Programming Contest (NCPC) held in BUET in 2000. That was the first contest sponsored by the Government of Bangladesh. Unfortunately little enthusiasm has been seen in them after that event in promoting programming contests in Bangladesh. IIUC contestants managed to solve a problem in a national level contest for the first time. The door was opened by Md. Sanaulah, Md. Ali Khan and Md. Moyeen Uddin Bhuiyan. Besides them, S. M. Tanver Hassan, A. F. M. Mizanur Rahman, Md. Mahadi Hassan, Mia Md. Karimul Hoq, Jamshed Haider Siddique, Md. Golam Mostafa, Md. Shamsul Islam, Mirza Md. Abbas, Aklima Khanam, Rahela Aktar, Afroza Begum, Ruksana

Faruqui was among the first generation of programmers of IIUC. We regret for not being able to recall all the names.

The programmers of IIUC spent a very busy year in 2002. They have participated in several programming contests in that year. IIUC has organized a big scale programming contest on 29th July. It was called IIUC Inter-University Programming Contest (IIUPC). All the major public and private universities of Chittagong took part in this contest. There were 18 participating teams from 5 universities. The computer club of IIUC was in charge of overall organization. Prof. Dr. Md. Nurul Islam was the Convener of Organizing Committee and Mr. Md. Shamsul Alam was the Member Secretary of the same. The teams of IIUC got a clean sweep securing the top three positions and proved itself undisputedly as the leading university in programming contest in Chittagong region. Solving four problems IIUC Protector got the winning position. The proud members of the team were Md. Hijbul Alam, S. A. M. Harun and Md. Erfanul Hoque Siddqui. The female team IIUC Muhandisa got the 2nd position solving 2 problems. The team comprised of Farhana Haider, Shohela Ahsan Chowdhury and Saima Akter. Prof. Dr. M. Kaykobad gave the occasion a different dimension attending the contest as the Chief Guest. The prize giving ceremony was staged in Safa Arcade. The prizes were handed over by the State Minister of the Ministry of Forest and Environment Md. Zafrul Islam Chowdhury.

On 14th February Independent University Chittagong Campus hosted a programming contest which was organized by IUB computer club. In that contest IIUC showed the strength of her programmers and proved itself to be the best University among private and public universities of Chittagong as far as the programming contests are concerned. It was the first time that IIUC was the winner of programming contest held outside IIUC. In this contest IIUC secured 1st, 3rd, and 5th among the participating 10 teams. Most interestingly the winner of the contest was a female team, IIUC GOLD, of which the member was Shahana Yasmin Chowdhury, Farzana Afroz and Rehana Akhter Khan. It is the first and only occasion when a female team has been champion in an Inter-University Contest in Bangladesh.

On the 4th September American International University of Bangladesh (AIUB) hosted a nationwide programming contest titled AIUB Inter-University Programming Contest (AIPC). 65 teams participated in that contest from 32 universities. This is the first time IIUC achieved a great success in a national level contest. The team IIUC Protector comprised of Md. Hijbul Alam, S. A. M. Harun and Md. Erfanul Haque Siddiqui secured 12th position solving four problems. Another team of IIUC got the 15th position solving 3 problems. In this contest IIUC GOLD got Best Female Team Award among all the universities, be it private or public, of Bangladesh. The member of this team was Farhana Haider, Shohela Ahsan Chowdhury and Shahana Yasmin Chowdhury. In this contest IIUC showed the best result among the universities of outside the capital city.

On the 2nd November South East University organized another programming contest. This contest was simultaneously held online with the help of University of Valladolid, Spain. The problem set was a very standard one with problems posed by world's leading problem setters like Gordon V. Cormack and Derek Kisman. Majority of the problems was set by Shahriar Manzoor and he was also in charge of selecting the problems for the set. In my opinion it was the second contest in Bangladesh that constitutes of a World Class problem set. (The first was Electro Computers Day Contest organized by BUET in year 2000 where Rezaul Alam Chowdhury was in charge of the problem set. And the problem set of the selection contest of NCPC held that year was also a nice one, although in the final round, the problem set has got some bugs.) 56 teams from 35 universities took part in this contest. In this contest IIUC fall a little bit behind comparing to AIPC contest. Four teams participated in this contest from IIUC securing 23rd, 26th, 28th positions and one team got Honorable Mention in the rank list.

The 28th November was marked with the big event ACM ICPC Dhaka Site Regional. Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology hosted the contest. 82 teams including 3 foreign teams participated in this contest. First time in this contest the performance of IIUC got recognition in international level. From among all the universities, the female team IIUC Gold consisting of Farhana Haider, Farzana Afroz and Shahana

Yasmin Chowdhury has been adjudged as the Best Female Team. The proud members of IIUC Gold got \$100 cash prize each from Prof. C. J. Hwang, ACM ICPC Asia Region Director.

The very beginning of 2003 was marked by another contest. On the 4th January the CCA Programming Contest was held in Chittagong Computer Fair - 2003. There were about 36 teams mainly from private and public universities of Chittagong and 2 teams from BUET. Although the Problem set of this contest was not up to the mark, the team Earth Simulator representing IIUC managed to be the winner solving 4 problems. Another team of IIUC got the 3rd position solving 3 problems. The winning team consists of Md. Mizanur Rahman, Abu Zafar Sadek and Md. Safayet Ullah. IIUC Friends got Best Female Team Award. The members of the team are Sultana Akter Maya, Jannatul Ferdouse and Tania Alam

On the 8th March Daffodil International University arranged another Programming Contest. The team IIUC Simulator got the 11th position solving 3 problems. The team consisted of Md. Mizanur Rahman, Md. Syedur Rahman and K. M. Iftekhar. K. M. Iftekhar was from the Dhaka Campus of IIUC and on his maiden appearance he got a success. The problem set of this contest was prepared by Shahriar Manzoor, Online Contest Organizer and System Administrator of University of Valladolid Online Judge System. This set has also got some very good problems from world's leading problem setters. It was held online simultaneously.

The NCPC contest of the year 2003 was held on 12th June. Just before this contest was held, Shahriar Manzoor, Online Contest Organizer and System Administrator of University of Valladolid Online Judge System formed an Elite Problem Setter's Panel to help him in organizing online contests at University of Valladolid. The panel includes Derek Kisman and Jimmy Mårdell of whom Prof. G. V. Cormack said to the other guys of the panel to lean on them "to make sure that mere mortals can solve them (the problems)". Prof. Gordon V. Cormack as well as Prof. Miguel Revilla is the reviewer of problem sets. The Panel also includes two more guys from Bangladesh, Md. Kamruzzaman and Monirul Hasan Tomal. Kamruzzaman is truly a world class problem setter. Tomal is a great example for the computer science students of private universities. He has shown that with sincere effort and dedication anyone can reach the height of the leaders. The problem set of NCPC was organized by Shahriar Manzoor and Monirul Hasan played a major part also. The problem set was mainly the production of Elite Panel of Valladolid site. Tanveer Ahsan, lecturer of IIUC Dhaka Campus, was in the panel of Judges. He was also involved in setting up the contest environment. The IIUC Green team secured the 17th place solving 3 problems. The team comprised of Md. Abdullah Al Mamun, Md. Zia Uddin and Md. Syedur Rahman.

The AIPC contest organized by AIUB was held this year for the second time on 9th August. 82 teams from 38 universities participated in this contest. This contest was marked with a very hard problem set for the average contestant. IIUC Simulator comprised of Md. Mizanur Rahman, Md. Erfanul Hoque Siddiqui and S.A.M. Harun got the 10th place in the contest. For the first time, IIUC got a top rank in a national level contest. Only a few teams were able to get a rank in the contest due to the hardness of the problem set. Interestingly, IIUC Simulator solved a problem which was considered really hard by the panel of judges and only IIUC team managed to solve it.

This year IIUC have reached another land mark. IIUC is now participating in programming contests abroad. This year ACM ICPC regional Kanpur site was held in two centers, one in IIT Roorkee and another in Jadavpur University, Kolkata. A team from IIUC, IIUC Pointer took part in this contest from Kolkata center. The members of the team are Md. Mizanur Rahman, Md. Erfanul Hoque Siddiqui and S.A.M. Harun. There were so many problems in contest environment. IIUC team as well as all Bangladeshi teams suffered from network failure. Despite that IIUC team was able to solve 1 problem and secured the 9th position where the top most team solved 2 problems. This is the highest ever ranking IIUC have got in an international level contest.

The success history of IIUC was not build up in a day. There had been a long time effort and dedication behind to get into this position. As commented once by Shahriar Manzoor, IIUC is truly the most spirited university as far as the programming contests are concerned. Only IIUC have included problem solving in its



regular class work. Students of 2nd, 3rd and 4th semester has to take part in a two hour problem solving class regularly. Problems included in the programming contests, their solving techniques, standard algorithms and general problem solving techniques are discussed there. Open classes are also held regularly for problem solving for the interested students. A short length practice programming contest is held each week. IIUC also stages internal programming contests two times every semester. One of them is individual contest and the other is group contest. Students are regularly participating in the online contests organized by University of Valladolid of Spain and other Sites. Let us now look a little bit behind. In 1998 the IIUC teams started participating in ACM ICPC Programming Contest. To select the team a selection contest was held on 12th October. Md. Mahadi Hasan secured the first position. In setting the problems Md. Shamsul Alam and Abrar Hossain Quadery was involved. In the internal contests of IIUC held in 1999 the above mentioned persons were involved also. In the year 2000 Md. Mizanur Rahman, Md. Azizur Rahman, Md. Abdur Razzak and Md. Shamsul Alam were in charge of problem setting and organizing internal contests in IIUC. Taskeed Jabid, Syed Ashraful Karim Dalim, Md. Jamaluddin and Md. Shamsul Alam were the major contributor in 2001 in organizing contests at IIUC. In the year 2002-03 Riyad Mahmud, Md. Rezaul Bashar, Md. Mahadi Hasan, Jamshed Haider Siddiqui, Aklima Khanam, Md. Abul Hasan, Tanveer Ahsan and Md. Shamsul Alam were among the people involved in programming contest in IIUC.

The Dhaka Campus of IIUC is also staging now programming contests regularly. On the 26th July, 2002 an internal programming contest was held. Prof. Dr. M. Kaykobad honored the occasion being present as the Chief Guest. The effort given by former Head of the department of Dhaka Campus Md. Kamruzzaman, Zillur Rahman, Ferdous Ahmed Sohel and Rezwana Kursia was behind the success of this event. Md. Arafatur Rahman was the winner of the contest while Md. Chistia Chowdhury and Md. Nayemul Hossain were 2nd and 3rd respectively. On the 22nd May 2003 another internal programming contest was held in Dhaka Campus. Mr. Shah Abdul Hannan, the former Chief of Dhaka Campus attended the occasion as the Chief Guest. K. M. Iftekhar was the winner of the contest. Atiquzzaman Setu held the 2nd position while Md. Mustagis Billah secured the 3rd. Mst. Sabiha Faruque was in the first position among the female contestants.

That was the story of programming contest of IIUC. This story was not told if some generous people were not in front of us to lead, were not beside us to care, were not behind us to support. Prof. Mohammad Ali, former Vice Chancellor of IIUC has always shown great interest in the programming contest. He has never failed to



inspire us with his presence in any contest be it small or large. Our present Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. A. K. M. Azharul Islam has also been a great supporter for Programming Contest. He has used his influence and authority to help us in whatever way possible. Both of them have ensured that we get the necessary fund for arranging and participating in Programming Contest which is especially important as most contests are held in Dhaka and a lot of fund is involved. Our treasurer Prof. Dr. Md. Loqman has always ensured that we get the necessary fund as quickly as possible and also encouraged us with his presence in different events. Our Pro Vice-chancellor Prof. Dr. Abu Bakr Rafique is also another person who has always been there for us. He has supported us in many ways especially by ensuring that we are never in problem in absence of honorable V.C. Our Dean Prof. Dr. Md. Nurul Islam, has always guide us as our guardian as he always in any of our department occasion but his favor for Programming Contest has encouraged us a lot in our venture. Last but not any way the least it is our Trust Secretary Alhaj Md. Badiul Alim who had made it all possible by his continuous support. Though he is not in any way related to the technicalities of Programming Contest, he never failed to realize its importance and has made sure that we have what we need to achieve success. We also like to thank every individual in every divisions of our university as they have helped us one time or other and have encouraged and supportes us all the time. We cannot mention everyone by name here and that is a pleasure for us as there has been endless support for Programming Contest throughout our university.

There is a clear indication that the performance of IIUC in programming contests is improving day by day. Sometimes the performance of IIUC has fallen short but the boys and girls have showed their ability to regain their position and advance it ahead. We strongly believe that the success in recent contests like AIPC and ACM IPCP Kolkata site will encourage our students to do better in the upcoming Dhaka Site Regional. And we also do believe that one day they will make a berth in World Finals. Let them walk in the right path. Let us enlighten their way.

IIUC Computer Club: An Overview

From the very beginning the students of IIUC as well as the students of Computer Science & Engineering have been performing several extra-curricular activities. Most of those activities of the students of CSE go to the connection to computing. Consequently, it was felt that differentiated activities should be accumulated with the formation of an organization. To meet this demand teachers and students had been assuming to form a computer club.

Purposes

3. To organize seminar in presence of renowned computer professionals.
4. To publish magazine compiling, the articles written by the students and teachers.
5. To arrange workshop on various issues to ameliorate the students' standard.
6. To arrange programming contest.

July 26, 2001:

The Computer Club was officially formed with Prof. Dr. Md. Nurul Islam as the President and Md. Jamshed Haider Siddiqi as the General Secretary of the club. Md. Shamsul Alam, Syed Md. Ashraf Karim and Md. Enayet Ullah Patwary were acted as Vice-President of the club. Professor Mohammad Ali was the Patron and Professor Dr. Abu Bakr Rafique was the Chief Advisor of the club.

January 27, 2003:

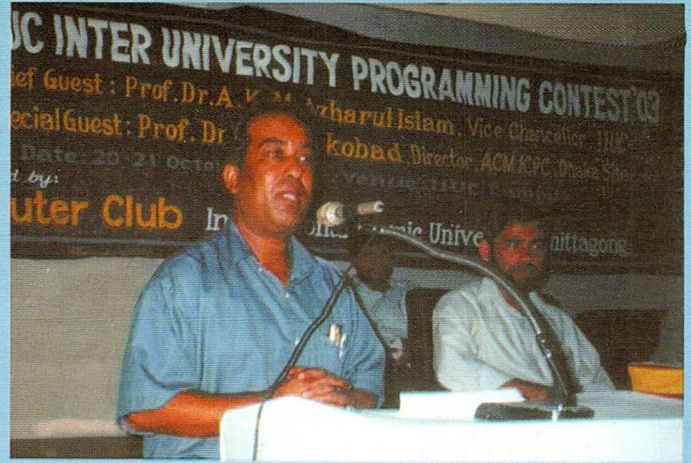

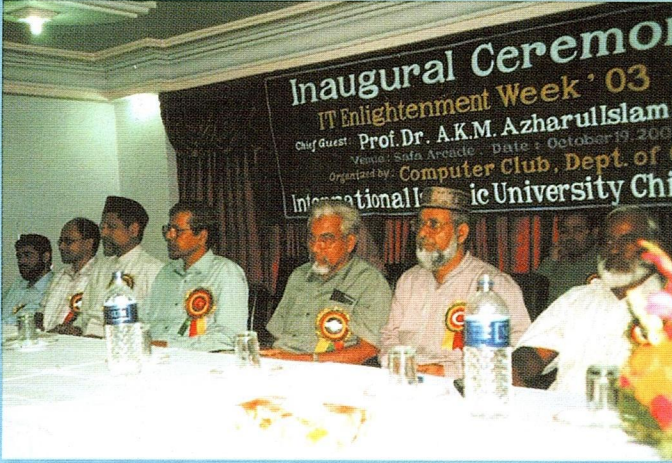
