Answer the following questions. Figures in the right margin are marks.

1. Prosecution story is that- *on dispute of a piece of land, accused A with intention to kill his old aged father F, gave him one blow and 2/3 hurts by a bamboo stick and he dies inconsequence. Post mortem report revealed that victim was suffering a particular disease accelerated his death though such amount of injury was not sufficient to cause death in ordinary course of nature. Learned Sessions Court sentenced him life imprisonment and fine of one lac considering it as murder.* Assume that you are the defense lawyer; accumulate your response and arguments in the purview of sections 299 and 300 of the **Penal Code, 1860** and with relevant leading cases. 2. (a) Define and mention the punishment of robbery. [5+5]

(b) *X, on his going to a journey, instructed his servant Y to keep the property safe until he returns. After returning from journey he finds that Y escaped with few valuable things from the house.* Identify the crime committed by Y and mention the punishment for same.
3. (a) **How do you differentiae 'simple' and 'grievous' hurts.** [5+5]

(b) *"Unlawful entrance or lawful entrance but unlawful remaining into or upon the property of someone with specific motive is trespass"*- do you agree with the statement? If your answer is positive, enumerate those motives for which a simple trespass is converted to criminal.

4. *Mr. R came to you chamber and told his story* that his 15 years daughter has been kidnapped and subsequently rapped by A, B, and C. They also threatened him saying that his daughter will be killed unless he gives 5 lac taka as ransom. He went to Police Station but failed to lodge FIR against them. Following the story, answer the questions-

- I. Which one and under what section/s of law are the appropriate court for filing case against the accused?
- II. Write down the punishment for committing rape? [5+5]

Discuss in detail the provisions regarding investigation of the offences under the **Prevention of Violence Against Women and Children Act, 2000 (amended in 2003 & 2020)**. Can the competent court grant bail to accused under this Act? [10]

5. During raid by Police, *Xman* was arrested with 100 grams of **cannabis (gaja)**, an unlicensed **Revolver** from his pocket and few **adulterated drugs** from his bag. During investigation police also found that he was previously arrested with **yaba**. Assessing the fact, answer the followings: [5+5]

- a. Identify the names of crimes with relevant sections of law he has committed.
- b. Are there any special provisions for repetition of narcotics crimes?

- a. Illustrate the acts regarded as prejudicial acts in pursuance of the Special Powers Act, 1974.
- b. Explain the composition along with the procedure to be followed by the Advisory Board constituted under the Special Powers Act, 1974. [4+6]
