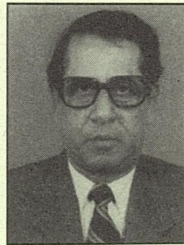
I am gladly expressing my feelings about the International Islamic University Chittagong, through this Souvenir which is going to be published on the occasion of the trust's conference.

P r o c e e d i n g s

The inauguration ceremony of two days long 2nd Biennial Conference of International Islamic University Chittagong Trust held on 27th January, 2000 at 9.30 A. M. at the historical Rajab Ali Ground (Parade Ground), opposite to its temporary campus. The Honorable Trust Chairman-Dr. Abdur Razzak Ahmed Dhafar presided over the meeting. The former President of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, His Excellency Abdur Rahman Biswas, was the chief guest of the program. The following were the special guests present at the meeting:

Apart from this about 1500 guests comprising of few senior teachers of Chittagong University, teachers of International Islamic University Chittagong, parents of the students and elites of the city graced the program.

Henceforth after the commencement of the session with the recitation from the Holy Quran, the honorable Vice- Chancellor of IIUC delivered his welcoming speech, beforehand expressing his heartfelt felicitation and thanks to the Honorable guests and trust members. His delivery illustrated the aims and objectives of the University and the need for a distinctive education and training.

Those eminent Honorable Trust members who could not attend the conference owing to illness and busy schedule, from among them the President of Maldives-His Excellency Mamun Abdul Gayyum, the Honorable Chairman of Kuwait International Islamic Charitable organization-H. E. Yousuf Jaseem Al-Hajjee; The Executive Chairman of Qatar charitable Society-Mr. Abdullah Mohammad Abdullah Al Dabbagh forwarded their respective messages on the occasion of the 2nd Biennial conference. The messages were read out respectively by Prof. Dr. Abu Bakr Rafique Ahmad, Dr. Tariqul Islam and Moulana Qazi Deen Mohammed.

Three separate notes of condolence on the death of three eminent Islamic personalities and saints-Allama Sayed Abul Hasan Ali Nadwi, Moulana Sha Abdul Jabbar and Mr. Abbas Ali Khan were read out by Prof. Dr. Mohammed Loqman, part time Honorary Treasurer of IUC.

Al Haj Mohammed Badiul Alim, Honorable Secretary of IIUCT, gave out a brief report of the trust activities of the past two years. In his report he highlighted various academic and economical activities. He also focused on the construction and development work in progress

at the main campus. His speech was followed by the constructive speeches of various trust members of IIUCT. Every speaker spoke out on the importance and necessity of the University and expressed oneness of spirit with the entire activities and objectives of the University. After the speech of the guests the inaugural ceremony came to an end at 12.30 pm.

The Honorable guests had a look at the land purchased and would be purchased at the middle, north and south campus as per the master plan, prior to starting the scheduled meeting at the permanent campus. They expressed their utter satisfaction specially at the sight of the plan of the three under construction academic buildings. Later on they arrived at the reception panel erected at the forepart of the south campus, they were warmly received by the University staff and local leaders. Both sides of the road were decorated with colorful flags of brotherly Muslim nations and tender school students pay their due homage to the honorable guests.

The second phase of the 2nd Biennial conference resumed at the permanent campus with the Honorable Trust Chairman Abdur Razzak Dhafar in the chair. At the meeting the Honorable Trust Secretary highlighted in black and white the progress of the construction work at the permanent campus, purchase of land and development of the site. He informed that The trust has been able to purchase an area of land of 6.72 acre at the middle campus, 2.28 acre at the south campus and 1.43 acre of land at the north campus. In his report he has emphasized the necessity of buying at least more 10 acres of land. Members present at the meeting analyzed the report and suggested to enlarge the capacity of the classrooms and also to reduce the construction expenses.

Later there was recess for Salatuz Zohar. The discussion on the trust election began soon after Salatuz Zohar as few important trust

members could not spare time till the end of the conference.

Allama Dr. Yousuf Quardawi delivered his valuable speech before the election. He wished that this University will play a vital role in the education sector of Bangladesh. He is optimistic that this University will one day be one like the other two Universities at Malaysia and Pakistan. Some internationally renowned Islamic personalities were included in the long list of the trust members. Among them mention may be made of Allama Sayed Abdul Hasan Ali Nadwi, His Excellency Mamun



Abdul Gayyum, President of The Republic of Maldives, Dr. Abdullah Omar Naseef, Deputy Speaker K. S. A. etc. Henceforth when the name of Dr. Abdullah Omar Naseef, Deputy Speaker of K. S. A. as Trust Chairman and Dr. Abdullah Abdul Aziz Musleh as Vice Chairman, was proposed. The former Trust Chairman Dr. Abdur Razzak Ahmed Dhafar along with the other trust members greeted the proposal (gave their consent in favor of the proposal.) The newly elected Chairman Dr. Abdullah Omar Naseef and Vice Chairman Dr. Abdullah Musleh took charge of their respective offices and in their brief speech to the members urged their earnest cooperation in building this University as one of the largest /eminent Universities of South Asia.

Later the chief guest former President Abdur Rahman Biswas and the newly elected Chairman of the Trust, Dr. Abdullah Omar Naseef, took leave from the interim of the meeting by helicopter owing to shortage of time and it was decided that the election of rest of the portfolios of Trust Executive Committee will take

place as per the previous schedule. Henceforth as per the schedule a gathering and discussion with the local personalities took place at 4 p. m. at the main campus. Moulana Mohammad Samsuddin, Honorable Vice Chairman of the Trust, Al Haj Mohammad Badiul Alim, Honorable Trust Secretary, Dr. Abu Bakr Rafiq Ahmad, Honorable Pro-V. C, Prof. Dr. Sabbir Ahmed, Honorable Trust member, Local Union Chairman addressed the gathering. The Chief Guest of this gathering was the Honorable Parliament member of Shitakunda District-Mr. A. B. M. Abul Kasem. Though he could

not attend the meeting in time due to traffic jam, he arrived before the conclusion of the meeting.

Public Reception:

Later on at 7 P. M. at Hotel Agrabad a public reception and dinner party was arranged in honor of the guests where all the teachers, officers of IIUC, Trust members, eminent personalities of Chittagong and reporters of National Dailies took part.

The reception program was presided over by the former Trust Chairman Dr. Abdur Razzak Ahmed Dafar. The gathering was addressed by Dr. Abdullah Musleh, Dr. Yousuf Al Qardawi, Naser Hamdan Al Za'abi, At length at 9 p. m. the activities of first day came to an end.

Second Day: 28th January 2000. Friday.

The first program of the second day and the 4th program of the two days long 2nd Biennial Conference started at 9.00 am at the University Auditorium. The meeting was presided over by the newly elected Vice-Chairman Dr. Abdullah Abdul Aziz Al-Musleh. In the meeting various agenda were debated by the local and foreign trust members with the following resolutions:

Subject: Regarding Academic activities and syllabus.

Resolution: The meeting discussed about the syllabus and curriculum of various departments. The meeting emphasized over the introduction of Islamic related syllabus and curriculum in other Faculties excepting Sariah Faculty. It was decided that the syllabus and

curriculum of Sarraih faculty should be integrated with the other Universities of the Muslim world. For this purpose a committee was formed consisting of the following members.

Sub: Regarding planning and Budget.

Resolution: The meeting came to a resolution that alongwith framing the yearly and five yearly plan and budget, the 25th yearly planning and budget should also be complied. The plan will include the development of relevant and structural development plan and budget. It should be prepared after Hajj before meeting the Honourable President of U. A. E. His Highness Sheikh Zayed Bin Sultan al Naheyen.

In this regard a committee was formed consisting of the following members.

Sub: Regarding the University Charter, Aims and Objectives.

Resolution: Regarding the above matter the Honorable Trust Secretary presented his report. A committee was formed earlier in the Trust meeting to prepare the charter, ideal, aims and objectives of the University. In his report the Secretary mentioned that the committee could not complete the report but it is rapidly in progress. Henceforth the meeting fixed the deadline as next June for the rel-

evant committee to complete their draft proposal.

Sub: Election of members of Trust Executive Committee.

Resolution: After electing the Chairman and Vice Chairman respectively Dr. Abdullah Omar Naseef and Dr. Abdullah Abdul Aziz Mosleh with the consent of all members, on the first day of the conference at Kumira, the election of the members of Trust Executive Committee was held the following day. The proposal was made by one of the senior members of the Trust' eminent Alim-e-Din Principal Moulana Abu Taher. He proposed the name of the V. C. of the University, one of the prominent scholars Prof. Mohammad Ali as one of the Vice Chairmen, present founder Vice Chairmen Sheikh Hadith Moulana Mohammad Shamsuddin and the Secretary of the Trust Al Haj Badiul Alim as the Secretary, Trust's founder member renowned preceptor Principal Mohammad Taher as the Joint Secretary and present Asst. Secretary, Founder member Moulana Qazi Din Mohammad again as the Asst. Secretary and reputed social worker founder member of the Trust, Moulana Mominul Hoque Chowdhury as Treasurer. The above proposal was cordially supported in a body by all the local and foreign Trust members present in the meeting. The chairman declared them as legally elected. Regarding the election of the rest of the Executive Committee members decisions was made that the rest of the member representing various classes of the University teachers and various categories of trust members will be elected/selected by their relevant category later on .

Established in 1995 under the Private Universities Act of 1992, Islamic University Chittagong made a very modest start with about 50 students. But over the last four years, it has made steady progress, thanks to a very hardworking and determined young Faculty. This University now boasts of a roll-strength of seven hundred students distributed in five Departments under three Schools: e.g. Shariah, Business Administration, and Physical Science, the Departments



being Qur'anic Sciences & Islamic Studies (QSI), Da'wah & Islamic Studies (DIS), Business Administration (DBA), Computer Science & Engineering (CSE) & Computer

& Communication Engineering (CCE). The current Autumn Semester enrolment has registered a growth rate of 40% over the intake of previous semester, which is a hopeful indication of a growing confidence in our Institution of the guardian community. By a happy coincidence the Conference takes place at a time when our first graduates are coming out of the University.

Distinguished guests, ladies and gentlemen,

We are fully alive to our responsibilities as well as our constraints. We are firmly committed to maintain a high standard of instruction that will ensure producing graduates capable of meeting the challenges of the New Millennium. You will be pleased to learn that in framing our various curricula, we have taken care to incorporate the essential elements of Islamic way of life and the innate principles of its philosophy drawn from the Holy Qur'an and our Prophet's Teachings. We consider this of utmost importance, in the backdrop of an incipient hostility to Islam and its followers, perceptible in various parts of the world. Needless to say this is not a very happy situation. No Institution should be indefinitely fed on charity; it must be self-reliant. Paradoxically enough, we can achieve self-dependence only through substantial and sustained Institutional assistance rather than individual charity. There is nothing wrong in individual charity, as long as it springs from magnanimity. But, there is no denying the fact that there is opprobrium and indignity inherent in solicited charity. Hence, the importance of Institutional assistance. May I therefore, on behalf of the IIUC Trust and my own behalf, request our eminent guests from Arab Countries & OIC, to kindly secure for us as much assistance, as is compatible with our objectives, and our activities and performance so far.

And I take this opportunity to call upon the more fortunate and affluent section of the citizenry of Chittagong to come to the aid of this new University trying to find its feet, and thereby help the Institution cater meaningfully to the growing needs of higher education in this region.

Before I conclude, I must heartily thank our eminent Chief Guest as well as other guests from home and abroad for making it to the Second Bi-ennial in spite of their preoccupations. And many thanks for bearing with me.

On 14.5.98 a Regional Conference at Kuwait was held and came up with 14 points resolutions that was straightaway acted upon; likewise, proceedings from different quarters as well, came forth -all have been up to 80% materialized by Allah's grace, IIUCT has got, to its credit, as many as 41 sessions of its Executive Committee held during the period (98-99) and took earnest decisions towards progressive and conspicuous development of all sorts, of which the following are important few,

- a) The decision for introducing Executive MBA on 3.5.98
- b) Offering Diploma Course under Computer Science & Engineering
- c) Electronics and Computer Communication Dept. opened on 24-8-98
- d) A service Center for Electro-Communication opened under the aegis of International Islamic Charitable Organization (IICO).

- b) Computer Lab, Physical Lab, etc. has been extended and reformed.
- c) A full fledged new Pay-Scale (unlike one anywhere in Private Universities here) has been put in force with effect from July, '98
- d) Out of many, one troop of five Members Delegation headed by the V. C. visited Sri Lanka and Maldives in '99.

Our Motto being the 'Islamization of Knowledge', IIUC is committed to promote higher education in Madrasah sector where financial assistance is a must; hence the ' Student Welfare Committee' is so predominant here. It allocated Tk. 2500 each to 23 students along with essential expenses in terms of stationeries, books, food and clothing etc. Over and above, the 5% of the total students have been allowed Free Studentship under UGC directives. Needless to say, this vital sector has to raise the necessary Fund out of the public donation and philanthropy.

Hon'ble presence,

We are lucky enough to have been able to procure about 8 Acres of land where three large and expensive buildings are well ahead in terms of construction; while construction works of more 3 buildings are underway to start in no time.

Ladies and gentlemen,

I am at the end-point here, afraid of, if I had over taxed your patience; nevertheless, it is our sincere exposition of ourselves for your kind perusal and consideration. I trust this much that we could do, is encouraging for further enterprise of IIUCT to go ahead. 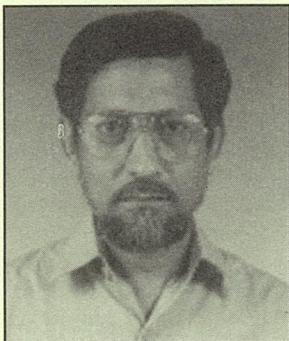
Preamble:

After the advent of the British and their occupation of power through colonialization, the education was squeezed up and it became so expensive that the only elite class could afford to send their children to schools, more over, most of the schools were run by the missionaries. These missionaries were alien to Islam and the Muslims, alien to the Islamic culture and even Arabic Persian language. During the whole of their rule in Bengal for a period of nearly 200 years the British didn't patronize Muslim education and Islamic Institutions excepting the Calcutta Madrasah and its a few branches in East Bengal and Assam which was mainly established to produce some Muslim officers to look after the Muslim affairs under the British policy. Though the Muslims got rid of British rule in 1947 after a long struggle, and established an Independent Muslim State, named Pakistan, but the Pakistani regime had failed to bring any meaningful changes in the education system of the country during 24 years of its rule, except inclusion of some books on Islam under the name of religious education. Same is the case with Bangladesh. The situation has rather been worsened by reducing the syllabus and squeezing the scope of Islamic & Religious education in the whole of education system. In 1977 an International Conference on Islamic Education was held at Makkah to study the needs of Islamic Education and help introducing Islamic Education System in the Muslim world. Among many important recommendations made by the conference, it had recommended for establishing three Islamic Universities of international standard in three most important Islamic countries, namely: Bangladesh, Pakistan and Malaysia. All the member countries were requested to render all possible financial and technical assistance for ensuring all modern facilities for the students. Taking the advantage of this recommendation Pakistan and Malaysia had established their Universities during early

eighties but Bangladesh could not start earlier than 1986, which had to face a tragic decision of the government within five years of its establishment for shifting it to a remote village of Kustia closed to the Indian border. After that it lost all attraction of the nation, and all interests of the donor countries. All aspirations of the people were reduced into disappointment.

This is why the people who had been looking forward for establishment of an Islamic University in the country had to make meaningful efforts for an alternative. The establishment of the IIUC is nothing but an alternative.

Considering the unconducive environment for education, and unhealthy atmosphere which prevails in most of the public Universities of Bangladesh, the

Government of Bangladesh opened the door for establishing Universities on private level by some philanthropist persons or organizations, through its historic Act named as '*Bangladesh Private University Act 1992*'. This historic act witnessed a very positive response. Within a short span of three years' time i. e. 1992-95 as many as sixteen Private Universities, were established throughout the country, and many others are waiting for government approval. Thus a forum for competition in offering the better education has been opened through these Universities. Now education is no longer a monopoly to some public institutions, that they sell it as they like, but rather it is now an item of perfect competition, where the standard and quality must be ensured to be sold out. This is certainly a healthy situation in the arena of education.

The International Islamic University Chittagong (IIUC) had started functioning in August 1995 with only three Departments under three Faculties and one Institute. Starting its academic activities with only 45 students in the 1st intake in 1995, during the short span of four years the strength of students population is to exceed one thousand by

the Spring intake of 2000. The number of departments is also increased into five and an Executive MBA course has been introduced as a week end program for the working executives. Apart from these, IIUC's Certificate and Diploma courses in Modern Arabic and in Computer Technology has got great popularity among the students and the competition for getting a place therein has become tougher.

The Curriculum and Evaluation System of IIUC:

IIUC follows the semester system of curriculum and Grading System of evaluation, having the Credit Hour System of course distribution. A student has to finish 128 to 140 credit hours for graduation, during a period of 8 semesters or 4 years. Presently IIUC is

offering only two semesters a year. The Autumn Semester begins September and the spring Semester being in March each year. The duration of each semester is 15 weeks lecture period, with one week's break in the middle of each semester and 6 week's break between two semesters, excluding the examination period.

The Philosophy of Education at IIUC:

IIUC's philosophy of education is compatible with that of Islam, pertaining to education. It looks at the education as an integrated system of knowledge, which combines in a man the knowledge about his Creator, giving unto Him the due and establishing a close relation

with Him as His servant and vicegerent in the earth, and knowledge about the responsibilities to be performed by him in this capacity. This philosophy of education aims at creating complete awareness among the students about the glorious past of the *Muslim Ummah*, the problems being faced by them in the field of scholarship and creating a sense of responsibilities for making proper efforts for regaining that glorious position of the past.

IIUC's Program of education is also to create a new generation of educated and enlightened youths having high skill of professionalism, excellence of performance, balanced personality, high morality and good ability for facing the challenges of new millenium.

This is the Islamic philosophy of education which is called "*Islamization of knowledge*".

IIUC Faculties and their qualities required:

IIUC is still a nascent institution, but our prime importance has always been put on recruiting the highly qualified, professionally excellent and morally ideal faculties. We recruit only those promising youths as our academic and administration staff members who, in addition to possessing all qualities, are

committed enough for building up a new generation to redress the challenges of coming millenium with success. A good proportion of our staff members have had their education or training abroad, fluent in either each of the two major foreign languages (i.e, Arabic & English) or one of them.

The number of regular faculty members is presently 40, on the top of this, there are about 40 more senior teaching resource in the level of Professor & Associate Professor at some other universities and institutions of higher learning, who have been assigned for conducting different courses on part time basis.



The Master Plan of IIUC At Kumira

The Master plan for IIUC at Kumira envisaged as an emblem of learning with the core spirit of Islamic Culture or code of conduct.

The seat of learning i.e. the Academic City is entered through a water-court extending axillary North-South, creating a vista, viewed through the Gate-House Complex, an Islamic-Aesthetic reminiscence of layering colours as that at the great Al-Hamira of Cordova.

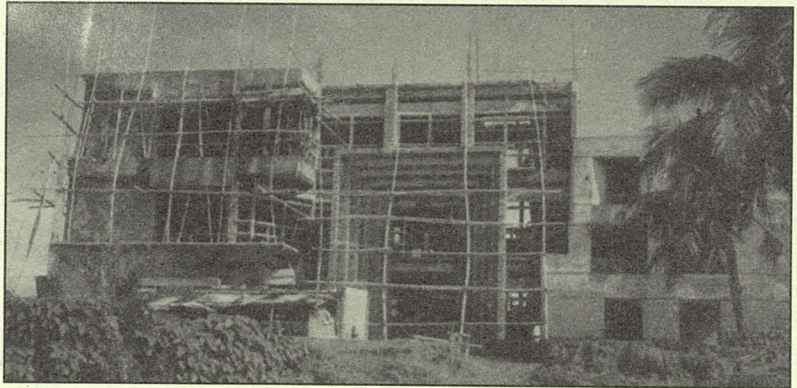
The water-court is flanked by the brick-vaulted Apex of knowledge, the

Central Library at the right side, while, the triangular-glazed-slope encasing the modern tools of learning i.e. the Computer Lab on left.

The right side-an apex of historicity by enmassing brick-terra cotta layers depict the history, the growth of civilization on round brick-vault on water, while, on left, the high-tech quality of construction, as fair concrete structure houses the computer center-also floats on water.

The academic environment is given the high level of prominence to the spirit of privacy-the lady students shall move

through corridors at Persian Garden & reach into the classrooms where they shall take lesson together with boys, but with a complete sense of "purda". The girls can seat in classroom with privacy, a complete seclusion, can enjoy common room facilities, also can loiter around every where they have their privacy.

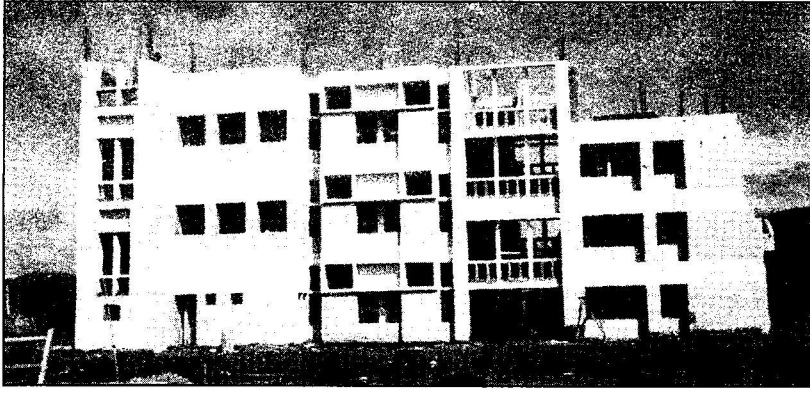


Construction work of Academic Building-1, Finance by O.I.C solidarity fund in progress.

Even at the Language Laboratories of Arabic and English, also at Electronic Lab, so also at the Mosque, Cafeteria and Lecture Theatre there is a complete separate entity of space with definite environment of privacy of the girls from the boys.

Thus the sister's movement within the campus is dealt with complete privacy, through the help of various techniques like, zoning, partitioning, porous corridors, sky-walks vertical circulation, etc.

Contemplation, concentration and sense of purda are the enlivening agendas for the

campuscape of the IUC's Central Campus.

The academic clusters are cities within the city contemplating within surrounded by green mountains or, lush green follages around.

A circular vehicular thorough-fare sweeps the student's vista to different spots, after crossing the entrance water where the skew away trapezoidal volume of the Mosque invites with its axial dome of light.

The pedestrian drop-off points at Electronic Lab, two Language Institutes al express a sense of containment under over-extended over-hang of the top roof at each entrance of these buildings.

The central cafeteria, only single-storied structure plays a role of breath taking set back with its two wing like roof-canopy, hovering out to invite the campuscapes here also the sisters can enjoy the extension of seats on out-side at the Persian Garden from where they can walk-up in the sky to cross over the road to reach the Lecture Theater.

The meandering nature of metal road extending away from the circular loop towards the North, passing through 2 hostel blocks helps the experience to travel far beyond the designed campus towards the lush-greeneries in the remote North.

Ways, a three-dimension-crescent-sweep of the Shariah Faculty position itself to set a focus towards the remote West. The IUC

campus invites the knowledge thirstiers through 2 free-standing yet cut-away R.C.C. arches on the fore-front, beside the Dhaka-Chittagong Trunk Highway the campus leading metal road meets a junction at a circular island where on right the campus extends at the South Campus. Here, on gradual slope, the most grand house of the V.C. stands with a symbolic structure alike the gate-structure at the fore-front, with a continuous vista created through a trickling down of cascade of light from the triangular atrium opening of this Administrative Building. A huge conference is bridged to this building which sits atop of tiny hill. Through series of terraces naturally shaped from the slopes of hill, makes an invitation towards the Academic Affairs, Human Resource and the Finance Buildings and more higher to East towards the Rest House-fresh at a hill top-splashing never ending vistas all around.

The gradual slope when extends to more South, a cluster of students' hostel seating quiet beside the shadows of high hills are reached.

The Master Planing takes care of ever-growth of the campuscape within pours, plains or undulation, either shaded in deep lush green, or bathed under warm sunny breeze, the Architectural idiom exercised in Modern Vocabulary inspired from the Islamic-spirit of pursuits of knowledge.



Highlights on Students' Co-Curricula Activities

Students' co-curricula activities are organized by Student Affairs Division (STAD). In fact, STAD assists in students' personal and career development in accordance with the university's philosophy and objectives. It provides counseling and guidance to students in their non academic activities, organizes formal and informal activities and ensures various facilities to satisfy their needs towards that end. The major objective of the STAD is to create values of 'Taqwa' and 'Adab' in them in addition to their intellectual and professional achievement.

Orientation:

The Orientation program (normally for 2-3 days) is scheduled before the Commencement of every new semester to make new students acquainted with the University system, rules and regulations pertaining to academic and Co-Curricular activities, faculty members. It introduces students to the programs of study, campus organization and services within the University through informal discussions and activities.

Orientation Program for the Freshers of IIUC, Dhaka Campus.

IIUC established its Dhaka Campus in December 1999. Undergraduate Program in Business Administration started from Spring Semester 1999-2000. Student Affairs Division organized a day long Orientation Program for the Freshers on 3rd April, 2000. Mr. Shah Abdul Hannan, the Chief of Dhaka Campus president over the meeting while Prof. Mohammad Ali, V.C. of IIUC was the Chief Guest. Address of welcome were given by Mr. Md. 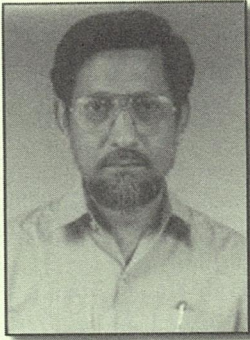

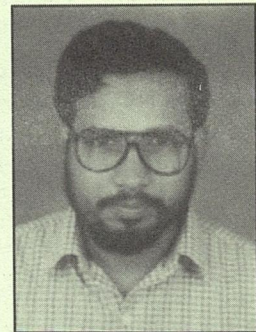

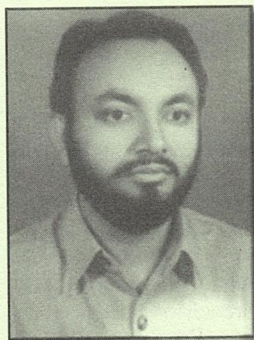

11. The University has signed Memorandum of Understanding (M o U) with several foreign Universities, which give the students greater opportunities for higher education and credit transfer in these Universities.

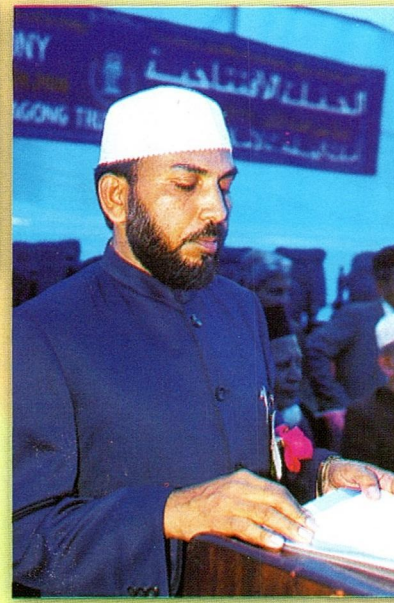

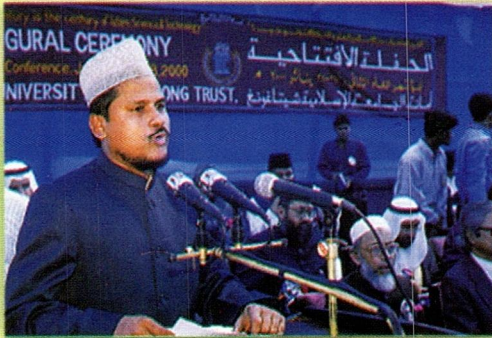

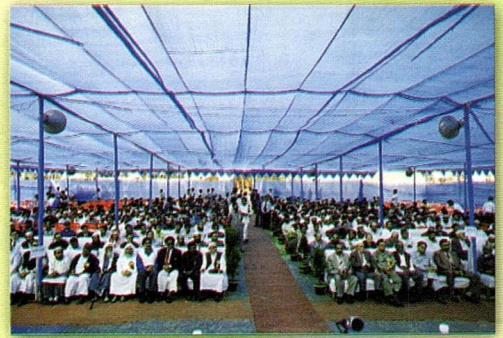

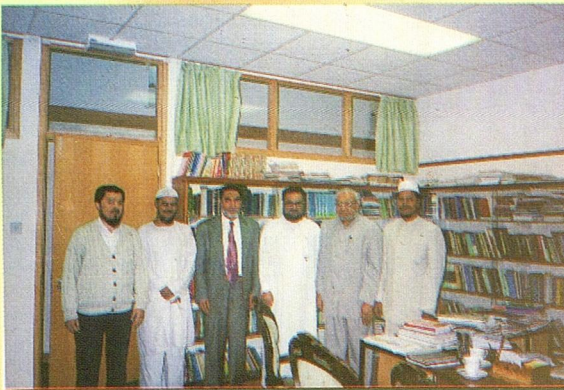

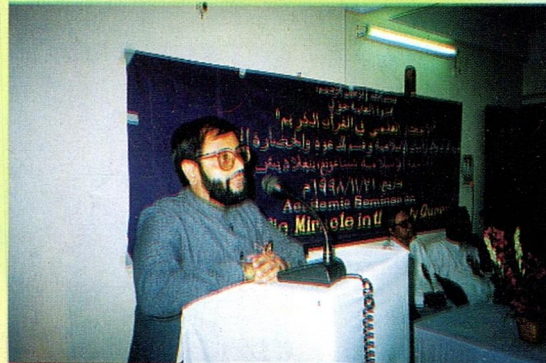
