1. (a) What is meant by ligature marks? [3+7]

(b) *It is not uncommon in Bangladesh and possibly elsewhere to kill a victim and then suspend the dead body from a tree or ceiling to mislead the relatives and the police with the cunning objective of escaping from the punishment.* Considering the above statement, typically point out the symptoms and postmortem appearances of suicidal and homicidal death by hanging.
2. (a) "Witness may lie but not the evidence"; -In view of it, point out the importance and objectives of a medico-legal autopsy to find out the cause of death.
(b) What is a viscera report? Discuss the relevancy of it in the trial. [5+5]
3. Discuss the medico-legal importance of the legitimacy of the child. How is paternity established in law? [10]
4. Define medical ethics. What kinds of legal actions may be taken against the physicians for their malpractices and professional misconduct under the Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council (BM&DC) Act, 2010? [10]
