5. **Give a legal opinion on the following issues under the Cannons of Professional Conduct and Etiquette:** 2×5
 - a) Mr. X is an advocate representing the plaintiff in a suit concealing the fact from his client that he is the defendant's cousin.
 - b) During the cross-examination of the plaintiff, the plaintiff's lawyer raised serious objections against the defendant's lawyer, and the situation got out of control of the Court due to their attacking conversation with each other.
 - c) In a district Bar Election, some local terrors hijacked a ballot box. One of the terrors was arrested, and according to his confessional statement, the ballot box was recovered; he also admitted in the statement that a lawyer ordered it to contest the election.
 - d) Mr. X, an advocate purchased an immovable property from his client (plot no. RS-1102 & BS-520) in lieu of his remuneration.
 - e) Mr. Mahdy, an advocate of the Chittagong Court, advised his client to abscond or leave the country so that the law-enforcing agency could not arrest him.
